




Projects

In this chapter, you will learn how to setup and manage a project with underlying datamodels and analyses. To add a datamodel or an analysis, you first need to create a project. Only users with the *Global Content Administrator* role are able to create new projects.

To create a new project click on:  on your homescreen. If you do so, you have to set the name of your new project and confirm with .
