Foreign keys are required for your data model to work sufficiently.

By clicking on [blocked URL](#) , new foreign keys can be generated.

To do so, select the tables in the first line's dropdowns. After a click on [blocked URL](#) a new selection possibility for the table's columns will appear in the next line. Select the columns that should be used for the foreign key relationship. Multiple columns for the foreign key relationship can be chosen here.
